



## **SAFETY & DUTY OF CARE**

When selecting a camp site, particularly in a remote area, it may be helpful to consider the following:

1. Check your surroundings. Is it safe to stay there.
2. Identify any potential risks and try to eliminate or reduce your exposure to them.
3. Don't park too close to others or block access routes in case of an emergency.
4. Please be considerate to others if you have pets or will be using a generator.
5. Be aware of hazards involved with the use of power cables.
6. Use existing fireplaces and only light fires if you are permitted to do so. Extinguish fire before leaving. Take rubbish with you.
7. Have a bucket of water close at hand in case of fire, know how to use your fire extinguisher, and have an evacuation plan.
8. Know what do in an emergency. Where can you get assistance? Carry a first aid kit.
9. Get your vehicle, caravan and equipment serviced regularly and understand how they work .
10. Remember, safety is everybody's responsibility.
